- Entries must be **postmarked by** <u>December 1, 2021</u> to qualify. Entries postmarked after that date will not be eligible for participation in the program.
- Points will be given for activities from October 1, 2020 to September 30, 2021.
- An event, activity or program may be counted only once.
- Only affiliate activities will be considered by judges.
- The affiliate association is responsible for keeping an accurate record of their activities (county, state & national) that are submitted in this award. The affiliate may be asked to show information regarding a specific activity.
- Please note: Please do not submit additional materials (scrapbooks, photo albums, etc.) with your application. Additional materials <u>will not be judged</u>. However, affiliate scrapbooks and albums may be brought to convention to be displayed at the MCA membership booth.
