

Missouri Cattlemen's Association
All-Breeds Junior Show
2022 Show Guidelines

- I. Check-in
 - a. Check-in will be done on a timed schedule between 10 a.m. and 6 p.m. with each breed assigned a timeframe. An additional time will be available at the end of the day for any exhibitor not onsite during their scheduled registration time.
 - b. Angus check-in will be handled separately in MFA Arena between 11 a.m. and 3 p.m.
 - c. Steer weigh-in will be held in the Youth Sales Arena from 2 p.m. to 6 p.m.

- II. No congregating will be permitted inside of the coliseum on the ground level.

- III. The breed show make-up areas and coliseum will be limited to the exhibitor, their calf, and one additional individual per calf.

- IV. The make-up area will be limited to one class "on-deck" at a time.

- V. Ring Lineup & Layout
 - a. North Ring
 - i. Exhibitors will line up in the eastern half of MFA Arena
 - ii. Exhibitors will enter the ring through the northern entrance of the coliseum and exit the ring through West gate
 - b. South Ring
 - i. Exhibitors will line up in the western half of MFA Arena and then be directed to the West entrance of the coliseum
 - ii. Exhibitors will enter the ring through the West entrance of the coliseum and exit the ring through the South gate

- VI. Junior Cattlemen's Association Board interviews will be conducted in the Youth Building.
 - a. The Youth Sales Arena will be utilized as the holding area with participants spread out between seating areas.
