MSU Bear Roundup Rules

All livestock will enter through gate 10 on Smith street north of the fairgrounds. Except between the hours of 6 pm and 9 am enter through gate 2 on Norton road

- CATTLE may ARRIVE ANYTIME AFTER 8 AM ON FRIDAY -

Check in will be 6-8pm Friday night and 6-8am both Saturday and Sunday morning

- This show is governed by official show flyer-entry form, MCCA rules, MCA points program rules and the following:
- MARKET ANIMALS and BREEDING HEIFERS will show by breed as listed by MCCA.
- BREEDS WITH 5 or MORE entries from 2 OR MORE exhibitors will have a breed division. Breeds with LESS THAN 2 exhibitors or LESS THAN 5 total head will still show in their respective breed BUT breed champion prizes may not be awarded
- BREEDS recognized with MCA and MCCA WILL receive points in their division and organization
- BREEDING HEIFERS may be shown in heifer show if DOB falls BETWEEN September 2020 and November 2021
- ALL PUREBRED HEIFERS MUST have registration papers in hand AT CHECK IN OR WILL SHOW CROSSBRED
- ALL HEIFERS will show by breed and age. HEIFERS MAY ONLY BE SHOWN IN ONE BREED.
- MARKET ANIMALS MUST be born in 2021. STEERS AND MARKET HEIFERS will show by BREED AND WEIGHT. NO REWEIGHS. Registration papers ARE REQUIRED for breed classes at check in; ALL OTHERS WILL SHOW CROSSBRED
- ALL ANIMALS MUST BE OWNED AND SHOWN BY THE EXHIBITOR
- NO HEMP OR HAIR OR HAIR LIKE MATERIALS OR SURGICAL ALTERATIONS
- ALL animals must be free of diseases. (Ringworm, warts) not limited to
- ANY AND ALL ANIMALS WILL BE SUBJECT TO VETERINARY EXAMINATION and out of state cattle must follow state of Missouri health requirements
- PORTABLE GENERATORS ARE WELCOME
- BEDDING IS NOT PROVIDED But the OEF FEED BARN WILL BE OPEN WITH SHAVINGS, STRAW and HAY FOR SALE. Feed Barn will be open daily from 8am-4pm.
- THE SHOW MANAGEMENT RESERVES THE RIGHT TO INTERPRET THE RULES OR MAKE ANY DECISION REGARDING THE SHOW DEEMED NECESSARY IN THE BEST INTEREST OF THE EVENT.
- NO SHOWING OUT OF TRAILERS due to space. YOU MUST STALL IN THE BARN and provide your own bedding
- NO altering animals fill; NO pumping; NO excessive drenching
- ALL HEIFERS WILL BE RELEASED AT THE CONCLUSION OF THE HEIFER SHOW AND ALL STEERS WILL BE RELEASED AT THE CONCLUSION OF THE STEER SHOW
- TO be eligible for SHOWMANSHIP CLASSES exhibitors MUST BE ENTERED IN A REGULAR CLASS
