ULES

- Barn space and camping available on a first come first serve basis. Trailer showing is an option with a \$25 refundable deposit (refunded upon release inspection). **Portable generators are welcome outside of barns.**
- The show is governed by official show flyer, entry form, MCCA Rules, & MCA points program rules & the following:
- Show starts with Showmanship at 10 a.m. Beginning with Seniors. Breeds to follow in alphabetical order.
- Showmanship Divisions- Novice (7 & Under), Junior (8-11), Intermediate (12-16), & Senior (17-21). Showman must be **21 & under as of January 1, 2022.** Showman must be entered in breed show to be eligible to compete in showmanship classes.
- Breeds with 5 or more entries from 2 or more exhibitors will have breed division. Breeds with less than 2 exhibitors or less than 5 total head will still show in their respective breed, but breed champion prizes may not be awarded.
- Breeds recognized with MCA & MCCA will receive points in their respective division and organization.
- Breeding Heifers- A heifer may be shown in Heifer show if DOB falls between September 2020- November 2021. All Purebred heifers must show proof of papers/registration at check-in or will be shown crossbred. All heifers will show by Breed & Age. Percentage Heifers may be shown in only one breed.
- Market Cattle- Must be born in 2021. Steers & Market Heifers will be shown by Breed & Weight. Market Cattle will have **no weigh backs**. All Purebred market cattle must show proof of papers/registration at check-in or will be shown crossbred.
- Cattle must be entered in and registered in the name of and shown by the individual. Exceptions will include only showman who become sick or injured the day of the show or exhibitors who have two or more animals per class.
- No fitting of animals in an unethical fashion will be tolerated. No attaching hair, or other hair like foreign substitutions for the purpose of deception. **Drenching or artificial means of filling animals internally is prohibited.**
- All animals will be subject to veterinary examination & **out of state cattle must show health papers at check-in**. All animals must follow State of Missouri Health Requirements.
- Bedding is not provided. Ozark Empire Fairgrounds feed barn will be open 8 a.m.- 4 p.m. daily to purchase shavings, hay, & straw on site.
- Show management reserves the right to interpret the rules or make any decision regarding the show deemed necessary in the best interest of the event.
- All cattle will be released at the conclusion of their respective breeding or market show.
